# Steps to Apply

#### Deadline: January 31, 2024

All candidates applying to Montgomery College's Macklin Business Institute (MBI) program must submit a credit admissions application to Montgomery College and a Macklin Business Institute (MBI) application with supporting documents through the MBI email at mbi@montgomerycollege.edu.

Applications for fall 2024 will only be considered for students who are currently enrolled in their final year of high school and who will be completing high school graduation requirements in May/June 2024.

- Apply to Montgomery College by December 15, 2023, to receive a College ID (M#).
- Download the MBI application from the MBI website at www.montgomerycollege.edu/macklin
- Complete the MBI application by January 31, 2024, and email your unofficial high school transcript, SAT/ACT Scores (optional), teacher recommendation letters and resume to mbi@montgomerycollege.edu

## STEP 1

**Complete Montgomery College Online Credit Admission** Application by December 15, 2023. To apply, visit montgomerycollege.edu/apply.

-You will receive a college ID (M#) that you will need to complete your application. -Please allow up to 2 weeks to receive your M#.

# STEP 2

#### Claim your MyMC account at mymc.montgomerycollege.edu

-Go to MyMC and click on "Claim Your Account." You will be prompted to enter your MC Student ID along with your M# (nine characters including the M).

-Once you are logged in to MyMC, set up your Montgomery College email account by clicking on the email icon. MC will communicate with you through your College email account.

### STEP 3

Have your official transcript and College Entrance Scores (optional) and letters of recommendation sent by January 31, 2024. Official high school transcript

Have your official high school transcripts emailed to the Macklin Business Institute at mbi@montgomerycollege.edu

#### College Entrance Exam Scores (SAT or ACT), are optional but recommended.

If you plan to submit your scores, the SAT Code for Montgomery College (Rockville Campus) is 5440. The ACT Code is 1723. Students should submit their official SAT or ACT test results from all test dates. The selection committee will review test scores from the SAT I. The committee will consider your highest scores for each section of the SAT I (evidence based reading, writing, and math) from any test administration date.

# Steps to Apply (continued)

#### **MC Remote Placement**

The Macklin Business Institute requires a placement level of English 101 and college level math to be considered for the program. The following students must complete MC Remote Placement by December 15, 2023 if you are not submitting test scores or if you do not meet the following criteria:

- SAT: Evidence Based Reading/Writing score 500+ or
- Reading subset score 26+
- ACT: Reading score 21+
- TOEFL: 90 or above (IBT) or 575 or above (paper)
- IELTS: 6.5 or above
- AP Language & Composition: 3 or higher

Students should take the MC Remote Placement for Math, and if you do not meet the above criteria you must pursue the MC Remote Placement option outlined in this website:

#### Letters of Recommendation

Have your required two letters of recommendation sent to mbi@montgomerycollege.edu by January 31, 2024. You may submit up to three letters to be reviewed. At least two letters should be academic recommendations from high school teachers. Additional recommendations will be accepted from teachers, counselors (recommended), employers, Montgomery College faculty, coaches, internship coordinators, etc.

#### **First Semester Grades**

Submission of first semester senior year grades is optional, but strongly recommended. For best consideration, first semester grades should be sent to mbi@montgomerycollege.edu no later than March 1, 2024.

#### AP Test Scores and Other College Credit

The selection committee will evaluate AP course performance and the college transcript and records of high school seniors who currently attend or have previously attended Montgomery College or any other collegiate institution.

Please submit the following with your application:

- Photocopy of AP test Scores
- Transcripts from any college attended/or you earned credit while in high school

- An unofficial Copy of your transcripts
- A copy of your SAT or ACT scores (optional)
- Essays and Resume
- Photocopies of AP test scores (if applicable)
- College transcripts (if applicable)

Complete Parts 1 and 2 (Part 3 is optional). Your essays should be typed and submitted along with other required application materials in an e-mail to MBI@montgomerycollege.edu by the January 31, 2024 deadline. Your essays should be attached as Wo or PDF documents.
