Students planning to transfer to a four-year institution should follow the MC **General Studies – HACL** Associate of Arts degree. This chart shows sample requirements at several Maryland State institutions. Check with each school of interest to determine which MC courses are required at the lower level – visit English major websites. Students typically take 1 to 4 ENGL Literature courses at MC; the remainder of English/Literature specialty courses are taken at the junior & senior level (300- and 400-level). Check requirements at each school carefully to avoid duplication – for example, at some schools, some English courses are considered "upper-level" and an MC course may not fulfill an upper-level requirement. *If undecided, choose common courses from several schools*.
