

MONTGOMERY COLLEGE AND CHAMBERLAIN COLLEGE INSTITUTIONAL ARTICULATED PATHWAY AGREEMENT

AGREEMENT

This Articulation Agreement serves as the formal collaboration document for Montgomery College (MC) and Chamberlain University to deliver seamless pathways between Associate degree programs and Bachelor degree programs. The approved pathways are included as a separate appendix to this agreement.

PROVISIONS OF THE AGREEMENT

1. The institutions agree to follow the joint program curriculum and course-by-course articulation delineated in these documents.
2. Both educational institutions will cooperate toward developing, disseminating, and presenting the articulated program information to students.
3. Graduates of MC who have completed the approved degree programs with a 2.0 or higher will be admitted in accordance with Chamberlain's degree completion policy.
4. Students intending to transfer should apply for admission by the priority deadline for the semester for which they intend to enroll.
5. Students are subject to all the policies and procedures of both institutions.
6. This articulation agreement is based on the present curricula contained in the appendix. Changes to and the addition of new curriculum can be made without completing the signatory process. The degree requirements will be reviewed biennially; the agreement will be reviewed every five years at which time the agreement can be renewed or ended upon the mutual written consent of both parties.
7. This Agreement has an initial term of one (1) year. Thereafter, this Agreement will automatically renew on a year-to-year basis for up to two (2) additional one-year terms. Both institutions at any time may initiate changes to this articulation agreement. Changes should be shared in written format executed by both parties, via email or USPS, with at least 30-day's notice for implementation. The contact at MC will be the Office of the Senior Vice President for Academic Affairs; the contact at Chamberlain will be Keana Green, Healthcare Development Specialist.
8. Notwithstanding any other provision of this articulation agreement, all information relating to student educational records shall be treated in accordance with the Federal Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).
9. This agreement goes into effect for the Fall 2019 semester. This agreement enables School's graduates, employees or faculty who enroll in Chamberlain College of Nursing's online programs or Chamberlain College of Health Professions online programs to receive a waiver of the application fee normally required by Chamberlain University and incorporates all current and future programs offered by Chamberlain University in the State of Maryland. School's graduates, employees or faculty who enroll in and attend the Chamberlain RN to BSN Degree Completion Option, RN-BSN to MSN, Master of Science in Nursing (MSN), Graduate Certificate, Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP) or Master of Public Health (MPH) and all non-nursing graduate online programs will be charged tuition at a group specific rate of Chamberlain's then prevailing tuition rate applicable to those online programs. The Chamberlain program and group specific tuition rate applicable to each program are set forth in Exhibit A. Exhibit A is subject to change at Chamberlain's sole discretion. For current tuition and fees, please refer to chamberlain.edu/tuition. This Agreement applies to all of Institution's employees, faculty or graduates

who are Chamberlain students, whether new or continuing.


