2. FIND A SERVICE PROJECT:

- Log in and click "Needs" on the left task bar
- You will be prompted to a "qualification" or waiver. Complete this step to access all needs!

3. LOG SERVICE HOURS:

You may log unpaid hours served with almost any nonprofit, government or community organization. However, service promoting a religion, political party or political candidate should NOT be logged.

- Reminder: Use the black "MC Volunteers, Log in Here" button!
- Hover over your profile icon (top right)
- Click "Add Hours" and complete ALL information!
 - If you volunteered in response to a "need" on MC Serves, select that need.
 - For volunteerism outside MC Serves, (1) enter the name & email of someone who can verify your service and (2) attach proof of service, such as a picture or email. It's easy!

4. EARN AWARDS!

MC issues three service awards each spring:

- Spirit of Service Certificate (20-99 hours)
- MC Spirit of Service Medallion (100+ hours)
- If eligible, the U.S. President's Volunteer Service Award (100+ hours)

To receive an award, you must:

- 1- Perform service between May 1 and April 30
- 2- Log hours and ensure they are verified by May 1
