The **EARN Early Childhood Education grant-funded program** will prepare students to work in a variety of child care settings with children from infancy through age eight. The curriculum consists of seven early childhood education courses, three ESOL courses, and a series of career readiness workshops to prepare you for the workforce. These noncredit courses may be applied towards the 120 clock class hours required for the **Child Development Associate (CDA) national credential**.

### This program will help you to:

- Satisfy the MSDE state requirements to work in child care in the state of Maryland
- Get started on earning credits in the Early Childhood Education program at Montgomery College!

### Requirements:

#### To apply for this program, you must:

- Have a genuine interest in child care
- Be a Maryland resident
- Have a high school diploma or equivalent
- Be eligible to work in the USA (*proof required*)
- Want or need to improve English reading, writing, speaking and/or listening skills
- Meet assessment requirements
- Want to make more money
