Must be 16+ years old by the time the course is completed Must have a social security number or Individual Taxpayer ID (may change with implementation of recent legislation) Fingerprinting (twice) Before clinical Before certification Background check Abuse/neglect Theft/larceny Substance abuse/sales/diversion

### How Do I get Started?

# Need to pass both tests with ≥80% in order to register. Takes approximately:

- Reading Test 30 minutes, 20 questions
- Math Test 30 minutes, 25 questions

### **Testing**

- After this orientation, you may take the tests for the basic math and reading comprehension tests.
- Immediately after in-person orientations
- Scheduled in the WDCE offices with Ms. Edith
   Bonilla
- There are 30 minutes allotted for the English/Reading Comprehension test and 30 minutes for the math portion (calculators are not permitted).
- 80% or higher on both sections is required to register.

# Course & HealthCare Facility Requirements

- Computer, laptop, ipad, telephone w/camera and internet capabilities to access course from home
- □ BLS for Healthcare Providers-CPR card from American Heart Assn
- Physical Examination by a Doctor or Nurse Practitioner
- Immunizations: Influenza (current year), Covid-19 (initial 1 or 2 dose)

- Visual acuity
- Hearing ability
- Olfactory ability
- Tactile ability

- Strength and Mobility
- Fine motor skills
- Physical endurance
- Ability to communicate
- Emotional stability
- Cognitive ability

### What is a CNA or GNA?

- CNA stands for <u>certified nursing assistant</u>. A certified nursing assistant or certified nursing aide is someone who has successfully completed an approved nursing assistant training program.
- □ GNA stands for <u>geriatric nursing assistant</u>. A geriatric nursing assistant is a CNA who has also taken and passed additional testing following their clinical experience in a long term care facility.



### What does a CNA/GNA do?

- CNAs work under the direct supervision of a licensed nurse (LPN or RN) and are an important part of the healthcare team.
- Perform direct care duties, including bathing,
   feeding, dressing, and ambulating.
- Collect important information such as vital signs, and intake & output and report it to the licensed nurse.
- GNAs may also take on additional certification and become Medication Aides and pass medications to residents in collaboration with a licensed nurse.



### Where can CNAs and GNAs work?

- Becoming a certified nursing assistant offers endless possibilities. As a certified nursing assistant (CNA) you can work in hospitals, physician's offices, assisted living facilities, adult daycare centers, home care agencies and in the school system.
- GNAs can also work in the above and are the preferred certification for work in long term care facilities such as nursing homes and assisted living.

#### **Two Certifications**

- You have the opportunity to obtain 2 certifications at one time in some of our CNA/GNA program.
  - - The knowledge and skills you learn from these courses prepares you for both certifications.
    - 1st Certification Once you have successfully completed the course (classroom and clinical), your instructor will show you how to apply for the certified nursing assistant certification. The fee is \$20. (Hospital-based courses only teach CNA).

#### **Two Certifications**

- 2<sup>nd</sup> Certification If you are interested in the 2<sup>nd</sup> certification (Geriatric Nursing Assistant certification), let your instructor know.
- $\square$  There is an additional fee of \$120 for this exam.
  - The hospital-based courses are not eligible to take this exam.
  - The GNA certification is not required for the hospital-based programs



### How long is the CNA/GNA program?

- The CNA program is a total of 8-12 weeks depending on location you choose:
  - 9 88 hours of lecture, discussion and hands on practice <u>required</u> by the Maryland Board of Nursing
  - 60 hours of clinical <u>required</u> by the Maryland Board of Nursing

# Part 1 - Certified Nursing Assistant Classroom & Lab

- In this course, students will learn basic nursing skills including taking vital signs, assuring patient safety, and caring for patients with variety of medical disorders.
- After successful completion of both the classroom and clinical portions, you will receive a certificate of completion from Montgomery College.

### Part 2 - Certified Nursing Assistant Clinical

  - Suburban Hospital



### What are the classes?

#### After BOTH Classroom and Clinical

- Upon the completion of the CNA program, the student must complete an application and pay a fee of \$20.00 to the Maryland Board of Nursing (MBON).
- You will need to complete a background check and fingerprinting to apply for your CNA certificate. Please bring 2 forms of ID.
- If you wish to be endorsed as a Geriatric Nursing Assistant, after completion of the course, you may apply to take the Geriatric Nursing Assistant Licensing examination for an additional \$120.00.
  - 2 forms of ID will be needed for CNA registration and GNA state exam.

### How much does the program cost?

- □ Certified Nursing Assistant Classroom (CNA) ▲
- 88 Hours
- □ Tuition waiver applies; seniors pay fee only. \$850 + \$275 fee = \$1125; Non-Md. residents add \$650.
- □ Certified Nursing Assistant Clinical (CNA) ▲
- □ 60 Hours
- This course is only for students who have successfully completed Certified Nursing Assistant—Classroom (AHT028).
  Tuition waiver applies; seniors pay fee only. \$850 + \$155 fee = \$1,005; Non-
  - Md. residents add \$650.
- The corresponding classroom and clinical MUST BE TAKEN TOGETHER, NO SUBSTITUTIONS. YOU MUST WEAR UNIFORMS ON THE FIRST DAY OF ON-CAMPUS CLASSES!

### How Do I Register?

 Once test results are reviewed and you have passed with an 80% or higher, your name will be given to Customer Service authorizing you to register online.

#### When registering online:

- □ Please use name that is on your current identifications
- If you use a name that is different than name on current IDs, it will be difficult to process your application with the Maryland Board of Nursing

### Registering with the correct name

It is important that the name on your certificate of completion, matches the name you register with.

If you have taken a course at Montgomery College and your name has changed, a name change form will need to be completed. Forms can be requested online by contacting WD&CE Customer Service montgomerycollege.edu/wdce or call 240-567-5188

### **Equipment Needed**

- Books and an equipment bag (stetethoscope, blood pressure cuff, gait belt, gloves, etc) are included in the price of tuition.
- Students must purchase white uniforms (white scrub pants, white scrub top, white shoes, white socks). You can purchase scrubs at Walmart or any uniform shop, or even online, watch w/second hand (no digitals) do not spend a lot of money on these items.
- Students must purchase a subscription (1 year) to the 3<sup>rd</sup> party medical information management service
- Students are responsible for their own healthcare costs.
