Call to Order

Approval of Agenda/Minutes

The minutes was approved as corrected. The agenda was approved as written. The meeting was recorded for internal use only.

Constituent Concerns

No constituent concerns were presented.

Chair's Report

The chair provided the following information:

- 10/27 College Council meeting
 - o MC received \$500,000 scholarship from Westat
 - o Receive \$75,000 grant for Student Emergency Funds from Lockheed Martin
 - Staff Enrichment Committee request to not have Staff Enrichment Day for AY21
 - Dr. Steve Cain announced the forming of Campus Expansion Committee
 - Discussion around the 4th campus advisory committee
 - Feasibility study for opening 4th campus on the eastern part of Montgomery County
 - Need 1 staff and 1 faculty Send volunteer names to Dr. Cain
 - o John Hamman presented updates on College enrollment trends
 - Increase in Distance Learning
 - Higher number of students taking classes on multiple campuses
 - Higher percentage of students are Dual Enrollment students
 - MC enrollment is down, but it's not as bad as the national trends.

- o Dr. Sanjay Rai presented updates on Academic Affairs
 - Shared articles that looked into issues in post-COVID environment
 - Since 2016, the College has saved students \$22 million using Open Education Resources (OERs).
 - Achievement gap narrowing
 - MC has decreased class cancellation by 46% due to using data analytics in scheduling
- Question Is the scholarship from Westat targeted at any major student population?
 - Presidential Scholars
- 11/10 College Council meeting
 - Recommendation Delivering food to students
 - Good idea, but a lot of questions and issues to consider
 - There may be liability and exposure issues with employees using personal vehicles to deliver food to students
 - Suggest to let CAT Team aware of this recommendation
 - Students are requesting toiletries
 - Bring a Constituent to College Council Day on 11/24
 - Recommendation Microphone and camera use in the classroom and requiring students to use in structured remote courses
 - Faculty Council recommendation was approved for continued review
 - Academic Regulations Committee strongly opposed
 - Hardware distribution MC Foundation provided technology vouchers and some laptops for students
 - Bandwidth issue a lot of unknowns
 - Engagement issue professional development for faculty on alternative ways to promote engagement
 - Privacy issue
 - A council member expressed that it can also be a heath issue.
 - Broadly speaking, it's not a technology or cost issue.
 - Recording class issues with consent
 - Amy Crowley moved to table the discussion around the document titled "Faculty Council Recommendation: Student Use of Microphones and Cameras in the SRT Setting" to be discussed under new business for 12/17 meeting. Kimberly McNair seconded the motion.
 - Vote unanimous approval
