### Achieving the Dream (ATD) Presentation- John Hamman

John Hamman gave a presentation on what ATD did in the past, and what ATD will do to ensure the success of Montgomery College's students and graduates.

## Policy and Procedure Updates

Kevin Long presented the following P&P updates:

- Compensation programs- most recommended changes were approved to move forward. Dr. Pollard will decide which ones will be updated first.
- Public safety changes have been approved, and will be implemented in January 2019.
- A language change with the Suspension policy has been approved.
- The confidentiality employee user release and disclosure information policy has been replaced with the confidential data management and security policy.

The following policy changes coming out in January 2019 for public comment:

- Disciplinary Action and Suspension
- Discharge of Administrative, Associate, and Support Staff
- Personnel Grievance Process for Associate and Support Staff Employees
- Prohibition of Weapons on Campus
- Prevention of Bullying and Workplace Violence

Forthcoming policy to be reviewed include:

- Modification of the Final Grade Dispute appeal process for students.
- Academic Regulations on class attendance requiring a review of Department of Education guidelines.

- New County Executive Mark Elrich was inaugurated on Monday December 3, 2018 Other noted County leadership positions going forward include:

  - Sidney Katz- Council Vice President
  - o Andrew Kleine- Chief Administrative Officer
  - Richard Madaleno- Director of Management & Budget
  - Robert Greene- Director of Rehabilitation
  - Chief Tom Manger will remain chief of Montgomery County police
- Ombuds released a Recommendations Report on October 19, 2018.
- Board of Trustees December meeting included the following actions:
  - Approved two new academic programs: 1) Polysomnography Technology AAS degree and 2)Homeland Security Certificate.
  - o Recognized Montgomery College Athletic Teams
  - Approved three naming resolutions for Montgomery College facility space/buildings: Institute for Race, Justice and Civic Engagement, Laboratory suite in honor of Dean Angela Pickwick and Campus Center room for Janet Saros

• Montgomery College will begin budget cuts of 1.5% for FY19. This equates to 1.9 to 3.9 million dollars to be determined with clarification from the County. The Board of Trustees will vote on Montgomery College's budget plan January 2019.

Dr. Cain stated appreciation for working with the College Council during his role as Acting President of Montgomery College. Dr. Pollard returns in January 2019 and Dr. Cain will resume his role as the Chief of Staff and Strategy officer at Montgomery College in January 2019.
