- Search Advocacy Program employs and participates in training that address current research about implicit biases, diversity, change in hiring, inclusive principles, and search committees
- MC is looking to be more inclusive so we decided to look at and explore this search advocacy program
- Look at hiring process are we being inclusive?
- Last Nov, a number of individuals, who are involved in this process, visited Oregon State University.
- Search Advocates help write job descriptions, be a listening ear and give impartial advice
 - Anyone interested can be trained
 - Work in all process of hiring
- Why Oregon State University?
 - o They are the leader in the whole process and developed the program.
 - A lot of different universities are being modeled after their program.
- Does the model go all the way up to the end of the hiring, or does it stop at the committee level?
 - Should go all the way through
- Standardized point system?
- No mechanism to ask about concerns
 - o What is being done to look at the potential problems and how to address them?
 - o Just starting, so a lot of the issues will be addressed gradually

- o There's a process, but it seems disjointed.
 - Who do people talk to?
- Model is still being developed
 - Need to look at each part
 - o Based on that model and crafted for MC
- Will search advocate be from the same department? Train everyone to be inclusive or pick someone to do that?
