

David Fisher is the author of *Presidential Chronicles*, the series of books and videos on American history as seen through the lives of the Presidents of the United States. He is on path to publish *robust but concise* biographies of every American President. Last Fall, Fisher released his first 3 volumes of *Presidential Chronicles*, which combine to include biographies of the first 15 Presidents of the United States. And just this month, he released Volumes 4 and 5, covering presidents Abraham Lincoln through Theodore Roosevelt.

These stories and perspective are also being shared on Fisher's YouTube Channel, where he's releasing a new video each weekday throughout 2022. The plan is for 10 videos per President, each about 10-12 minutes in length, for a total of 250 videos by the end of December. The Lincoln episodes started airing this week.

Fisher has been studying U.S. Presidents for most of his adult life. He has lined the walls of his home with his extensive collection of more than 1,100 first edition presidential biographies, dating to the founding of the Republic.

After graduating with distinction from Stanford University, Fisher has held career positions as a radio sportscaster, a management consultant, an executive in the Federal government, and a risk management expert. His leadership positions in government spanned the Department of Defense, the Government Accountability Office (Chief Financial Officer), and the Internal Revenue Service (Chief Risk Officer).

He currently resides in Bethesda, Maryland, with his wife, Helene, and their dog Chester.
