As a condition of employment, the following are required at the time of hire:

• Successful pass CJIS and Child Protection Services background checks (youth care standards); satisfactory complete training; submit health form reflecting ability to handle work assignments with youth and colleagues; attend a required orientation session (in person or remotely).

Following hire and prior to camp/program implementation: Assistants will start at least one week before summer programs begin in order to help prepare for and be oriented in the required processes.
