The <b>Shady Grove Transfer Credit Limit Exception</b> is available to students who earn an associate degree prior to transferring to UMBC at Shady Grove and will permit the transfer of up to 66 credits, instead of the standard 60-credit transfer limit, from a Maryland two-year school to UMBC on the condition that six (6) of the 66 credits are language courses directly applicable toward the 201-level language sequence required as part of the UMBC general education program.</p> <p>^ Select one course from each of the 4 UMBC Distributions below (four total courses).
