Students interested in pursuing advanced study in art education should choose 9 credits from AR 201/**ARTT 211**, AR 121/**ARTT 120**, and one course from AR 213/**ARTT 225**, AR 226/**ARTT 226**, AR 214/**ARTT 227**, AR 223/**ARTT 228**, AR 224/**ARTT 230**, or AR 225/**ARTT 233**.

†† Students interested in pursuing advanced study in art should choose one 200 level literature or writing course from EN 201/**ENGL 201**, EN 202/**ENGL 202**, EN 215/**ENGL 205**, EN 208/**ENGL 208**, EN 216/**ENGL 220**, EN 212/**ENGL 212**, EN 213/**ENGL 213**, EN 214/**ENGL 214**, EN 204/**ENGL 223**, EN 226/**ENGL 226**, EN 227/**ENGL 227**, EN 230/**ENGL 230**, EN 231/**ENGL 231**, EN 221/**ENGL 233**, EN 220/**ENGL 235**, EN 210/**ENGL 241**, EN 209/**ENGL 245**, EN 217/**ENGL 248**, EN 218/**ENGL 264**, EN 223/**ENGL 272**.
