

Peer Feedback on Writings in Progress

One excellent way to improve writing skills is to have an outside reader review your work and make concrete observations about it. This provides you with a more objective sense of how your writing comes across as well as its strengths and weaknesses. You may use this feedback form for essays you are writing for this or other classes, and you may use it for feedback on non-academic writings as well. The goal here is to enhance your awareness concerning your writing.

1. Does my piece contain a focus that addresses the topic/ question?

2. Is the content strong? Do you find my essay interesting and informative?

3. Does my piece contain a focus that addresses the topic/ question?

4. Does each paragraph have a specific focus that supports my task?

5. Are all the supporting details in my paragraph well-chosen and well-placed?

6. Is there coherence/continuity in my essay? Does it flow? Where do you notice that it does not?

7. Do my introduction and conclusion work well? How might I improve them?

8. Is my language clear? Are there grammatical errors that jump out? What are they?
