## Scholarships and Awards 2010-2011

The Rockville Art Department Scholarship Fund is an endowment, the interest from which goes to students majoring in art education, art history and studio art at the Rockville Campus. Each year, students apply for the scholarships by submitting scholarly papers or portfolios of their best work. All scholarships and awards are applied directly to tuition payments, and a number of them cover major tuition expenses for continuous full-time study in art education, art history and studio art at the College. A highlight of the academic year occurs at the end of the spring semester, when scholarship recipients are honored publicly at a special awards ceremony.

## Application Requirements

**Eligibility:** Matriculated **art major**, currently enrolled full time in the Montgomery College Art Department and/or part-time student who will enroll as a full-time art major (i.e. art education, art history or studio art) in the fall semester on the Rockville campus. To be eligible for a scholarship, a student must be a **U. S. citizen or permanent resident**.

**Criteria:** Merit, based on a portfolio review of work completed within the past two years and an Art Department faculty reference (from Montgomery College), letter of recommendation from High School instructor (high school applicants only).

**Portfolio Contents:** Studio and Art Education Majors: Portfolio should contain 10-12 pieces of two dimensional, original art work, &/or photographs or slides of framed or three-dimensional work. It is desirable, but not mandatory, that two-dimensional work be matted. The portfolio must include two drawings. Other work may represent design, painting, crafts, ceramics, printmaking, sculpture, etc.

**Art History Majors:** Must have a 3.0 overall average, submit two art history papers of at least 5 pages each, need to have been at MC for at least 2 semesters and have taken at least AR 107 and AR 108.

## General Directions for All Applicants:

1. Students are encouraged to consult Art Faculty during portfolio preparation.
2. Print your name on the back of each art entry.
3. Place a list describing submissions inside the front of the portfolio.
4. Attach label outside of the portfolio.
5. Hand in the **Art Department Scholarship Application Form**, a signed **Liability Statement**, and a form agreeing to accept **"Award Recipient's Responsibilities"** when you register your work.

## **Special Requirements**

### **Printmaking Award:**

#### **\$ 500 Marie Teixeira Memorial Printmaking Award**

*Additional Eligibility:* Art major currently enrolled in Printmaking and planning to enroll in a printmaking course on the Rockville Campus in the fall.

*Portfolio Contents:* Portfolio need only contain a selection of five original prints, no need to show editions.

*Return of work:* Printmaking applicants may pick up their work from Professor Carr during his office hours the week of \_\_\_\_\_.

### **Painting Award:**

#### **\$200 Bernard Michael Memorial Painting Award**

*Portfolio Contents:* Portfolio need only contain a minimum of three original paintings for review along with at least two drawings.

### **High School Art Student Scholarship:**

Include sealed envelope with High School Art Instructor's letter of recommendation.

## **Sculpture Awards:**

### **\$500 Sculpture Endowment Scholarship**

#### **\$200 Mark Giarratana Memorial Sculpture Award**

*Additional Criteria:* Montgomery College faculty reference must be from a full-time or part-time sculpture professor from the Rockville Campus Art Department.

*Portfolio Contents:* Portfolio need only contain a minimum of three original pieces of sculpture for review.

## **Sculpture and/or Ceramics Awards**

### **\$500 Sculpture Endowment Scholarship, \$125 Gertrude B. Wienckowski Memorial Award for Sculpture & Ceramics**

*Additional Eligibility:* Art Department major currently enrolled in a sculpture or ceramics course on the Rockville Campus.

*Additional Criteria:* Montgomery College faculty reference must be from a full-time or part-time sculpture/ceramics professor from the Rockville Campus Art Department.

*Portfolio Contents:* Portfolio need only contain a minimum of three original pieces of sculpture for review.

### **Ceramic Awards:**

#### **\$500 Toshiye Tanada Ceramic Award**

*Additional Eligibility:* Student enrolled in AR121, AR122, or Ceramics Practicum course who plans to enroll in another ceramics course on the Rockville Campus, next semester.

*Additional Criteria:*

1. Combination of excellence and need.
2. Written statement about why Art is important to him/her.

*Portfolio Contents:* Submit an *APPLICANT'S STATEMENT* (a statement of interest) and three to five ceramic works. Attach your name to each entry.
