

## **Distribution of Enrolled Credits, Full-time/Part-time Status, Day/Evening Attendance, Residence, Enrollment by Region**

### ***Distribution of Enrolled Credits***

More than one-third (38.5%) of the students attend on a full-time basis (12 credits or more)—a slight decrease from last fall’s 38.9%. The average (mean) credit load remained at 9.14 hours. This fall, there were proportionately more students in the 4-6 and 7-11 credit hour ranges, but fewer in the 1-3 and 12+ categories.

Of the 6,009 students at Germantown this fall, 43.2% were enrolled full-time at the College (down from 44.8% last fall), while of Rockville’s 15,816 students, 41.8% were full-time (vs. 41.9% last fall), and of Takoma Park/Silver Spring’s 6,586 students, 36.1% were full-time (down from 37.1% last fall).

### ***Full-time/Part-time Status***

*By Race* –The percentage of full-time students who are Black increased from 27.7% to 28.7%, while Whites decreased from 35.5% to 33.0%.

*By Age* – Among full-time students, 63% were age 20 and under, while only 29% of part-time students were 20 or younger.

*By Gender* – Of the full-time students, 50.6% were female and 49.4% were male. Proportionately, more male students attend full-time (41.6%) than female (35.9%).

### ***Day/Evening Attendance***

More than half of the students (60.2%) attend classes *only* during the day, slightly more than one-in-ten (15.4%) attend *only* in the evening (down from 18.4% last fall), and one-in-five (20.4%) attend *both* day and evening classes. Thus, a little over three-fourths of the students (80%) are here in the daytime and 36% are here in the evening. The Germantown campus had the largest proportion of students taking some or all of their classes in the evening (44%), followed by Rockville (37%) and then Takoma Park / Silver Spring (36%).

### ***Residence***

Montgomery County residents comprise 89.0% of the student body – 95% of the Germantown students, 91% of Rockville students, and 79% of Takoma Park / Silver Spring students were In-County. In-State, but Out-of-County students increased to 4.5% of all students. Out-of-State students rose to 6.5% of the student population.

### ***Enrollment by Region***

About four-in-ten of the county residents enrolled this fall live in the *upper* and *middle* regions of the county (39.1% and 37.5% respectively), while one-in-five (22.8%) live in the *down-county* region.

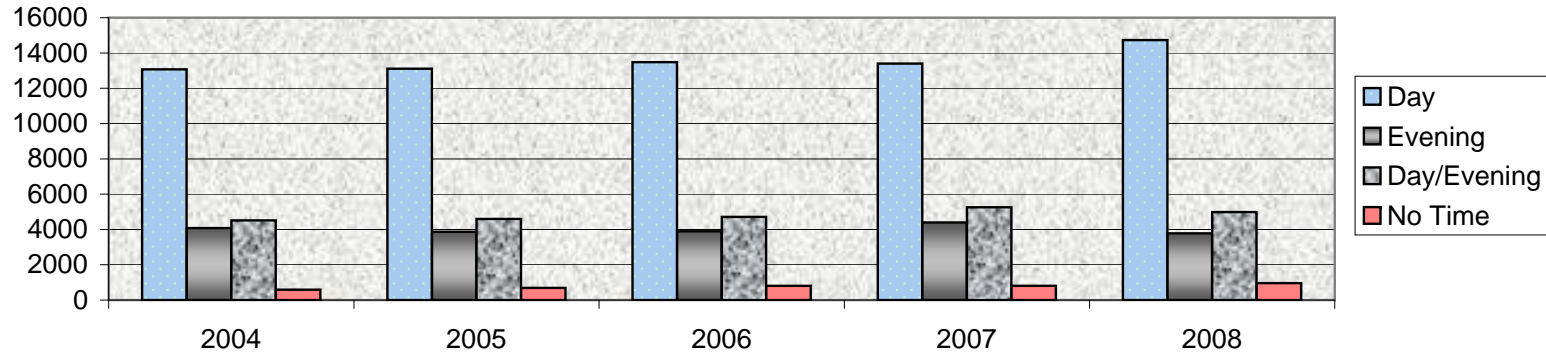
