

Enrollment by Curriculum

A little over half of the students (55.2%) are enrolled in a program of study designed to prepare students for transfer to baccalaureate programs – up from 52.3% last fall. Nearly nineteen percent (18.4%) of the students are enrolled in technical or career programs designed primarily to prepare students for immediate entry into occupations; however, students in these programs often do transfer to four-year institutions from these programs. This fall, 26.4% of the students have not indicated the program of study they are pursuing, or are not pursuing a degree or certificate – this is a decrease from 29.1% of the students last fall.

The proportion of students in Transfer programs has increased in the last four fall semesters, and the proportion of students classified as Undecided / Non-degree continues to decrease each fall semester, while Technical/Career program students have remained fairly constant.

The highest-enrolled degree programs at the College remain:

(2004-2008)**

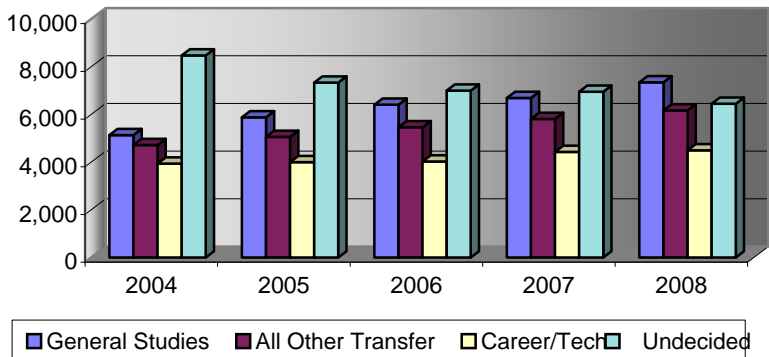

Enrollment Trend by Type of Curriculum - 2008

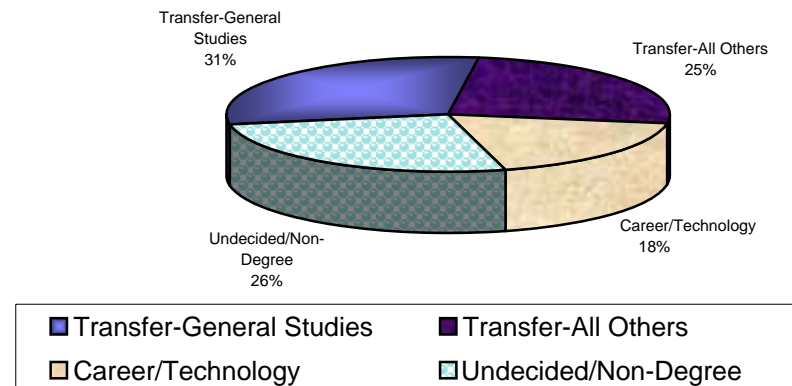
