

Enrollment by Curriculum

A little over half of the students (59.9%) are enrolled in a program of study designed to prepare students for transfer to baccalaureate programs – up from 56.7% last fall. Nearly one-in-five (19.5%) of the students are enrolled in technical or career programs designed primarily to prepare students for immediate entry into occupations; however, students in these programs often transfer to four-year institutions. This fall, 20.6% of the students have not indicated the program of study they are pursuing, or are not pursuing a degree or certificate – this is a decrease from 24.5% of the students last fall.

The proportion of students in Transfer programs has increased in the last six fall semesters, and the proportion of students classified as Undecided / Non-degree continues to decrease each fall semester, while Technical/Career program students have remained fairly constant.

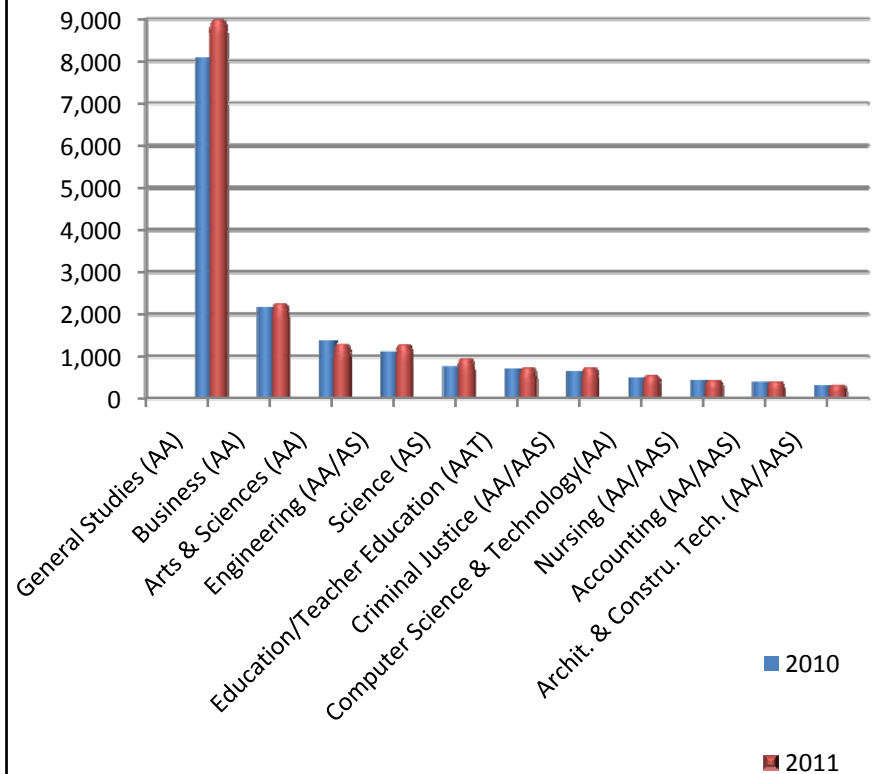

(2007-2011)

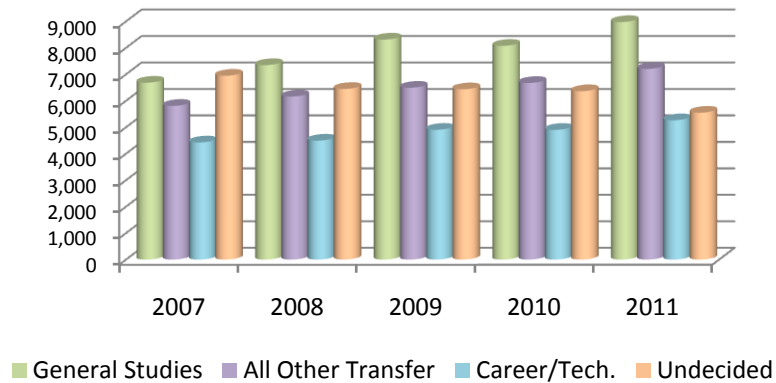

Fall 2011 Enrollment by Transfer/Non-Transfer

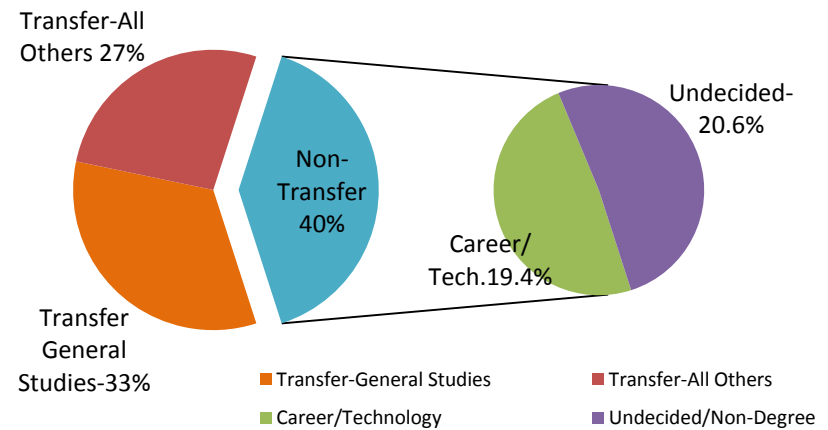
