UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND, COLLEGE PARK (UMCP) MARYLAND TRANSFER ADVANTAGE PROGRAM (MTAP)

For students who intend to complete a Bachelor's degree at the University of Maryland and want to take advantage of program benefits while completing a program at the community college.

- Begin to explore programs and take advantage of opportunities at UMCP, including Town Hall Meetings and open-advising sessions.
- Guaranteed admission to UMCP upon successful completion of the program (**see website for further information).
- A 25% course-tuition-scholarship for one University of Maryland course per term (not to exceed 9 total credits) offered at College Park or at the Universities at Shady Grove, after completion of 15 credits at MC.

UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND UNIVERSITY COLLEGE (UMUC) ALLIANCE PROGRAM

For students just starting coursework at MC toward an associate's degree, the alliance programs provide one curriculum plan for earning an associate's degree and a UMUC bachelor's degree seamlessly.

- Simultaneous registrations at your community college and UMUC.
- Waiver of UMUC's \$50 admission application fee.
- Access to the University System of Maryland library, tutoring, writing assistance, career counseling, computer labs, and more.
- Ability to transfer up to 70 credits if the credits earned are a part of an associate degree plan at MC.
- Eligible for scholarships in the amount of \$3,300 for fulltime students and \$1650 for part time students per year when transferring with an AA degree and a 3.0 grade point average.

UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND, BALTIMORE COUNTY (UMBC) TRANSFER STUDENT ALLIANCE (TSA)

For students who begin their college education at MC with plans to transfer to UMBC to complete a 4-year degree. MC students who have completed 12 credits with a minimum 3.2 GPA are eligible for consideration for the TSA Program.

- Access to UMBC/USG facilities and campus services including libraries and computer labs.
- Participation in student activities including cultural and recreational opportunities.
- Access to UMBC academic advising resources.
- Concurrent enrollment at a 25% tuition discount for one UMBC course per term (not to exceed a total of three discounted courses).
