

# ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

between

## JOHNS HOPKINS UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF PROFESSIONAL STUDIES IN BUSINESS AND EDUCATION and MONTGOMERY COLLEGE

Montgomery College (MC), a multi-campus community college in Montgomery County, Maryland, and Johns Hopkins University, a private research institution in Maryland, which through its School of Professional Studies in Business and Education (JHU/SPSBE) offers degree programs for adult part-time students, agree to offer articulated programs leading to the award of an MC Associate of Arts in Business Administration and a JHU/SPSBE Bachelor of Science in Business and Management, or an MC Associate of Arts in Computer Science, Information Systems and a JHU/SPSBE Bachelor of Science in Information Systems. The following principles guide the operation of this Agreement:

1. Students who complete an Associate of Arts in Business Administration degree or a Computer Science Information Systems degree at Montgomery College with a minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average will be able to transfer a total of 60 credits to Johns Hopkins University SPSBE BS in Business and Management or Information Systems with Junior Standing and begin taking the appropriate courses. Students who complete an Associate of Arts in Business Administration or Computer Science Information Systems with a 2.50 – 2.99 may be eligible for admission, with Junior Standing; however, all courses will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis. Montgomery College students who complete an Associate of Applied Science degree or who have fewer than the number of credit hours required for the award of an Associate's degree may transfer credits, but will have to meet additional JHU/SPSBE transfer requirements. No courses completed with a grade of D or lower will transfer.
2. Students may transfer a maximum of 60 semester hours to JHU/SPSBE. In addition, students may transfer credits back to Montgomery College in accordance with MC's academic regulations in order to complete the Associate's degree.
3. Students must complete 60 credits at JHU/SPSBE to earn the Bachelor of Science degree.
4. Montgomery College students who have completed a minimum of 54 transferable college credits, have at least a 3.0 GPA, and significant work experience may apply for acceptance into the JHU/SPSBE Advancing Business Professionals or Information Systems Program, which allows students to complete the BS degree at an accelerated pace.
