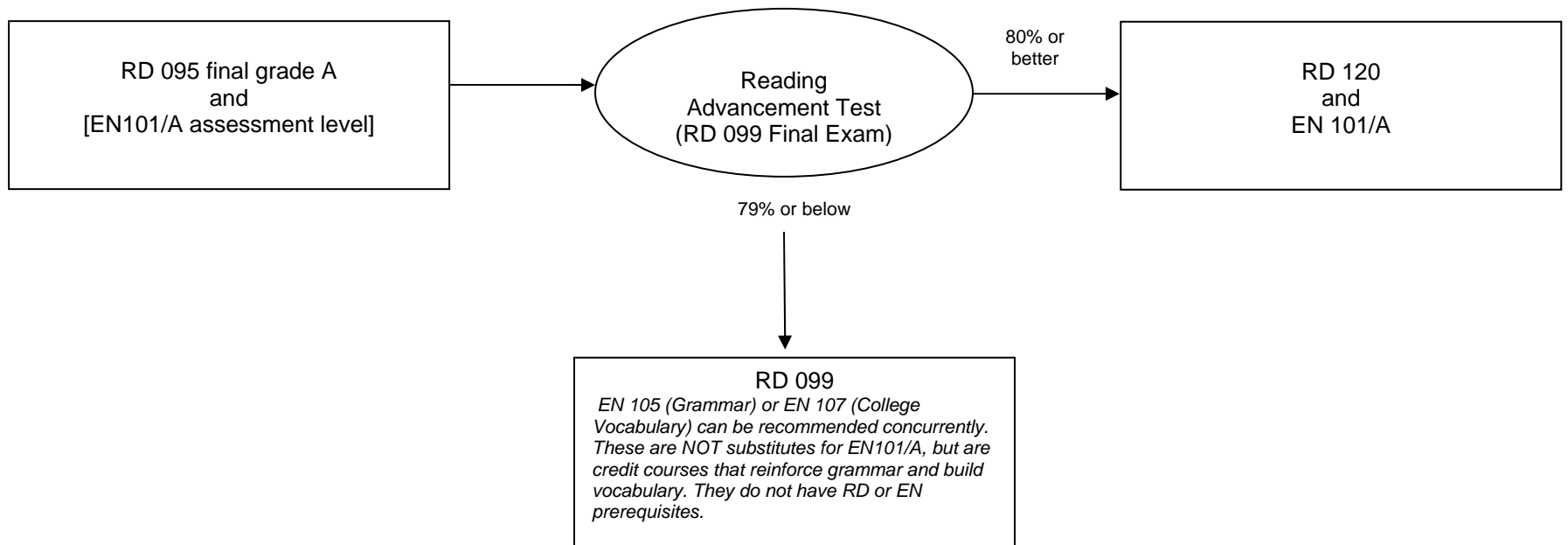


RD 095 - RD 099 - RD 120 Flowchart



Students who initially place into RD095 will have two (2) semesters of Reading. There is no “skip.” Rather, RD095 students will take the traditional sequence (RD095 followed by RD099). With permission of the Reading Department, a student may be eligible to advance to RD120 rather than RD099.

However, in order to be considered for this advancement, the RD095 student must meet these three requirements:

- (1) Earn an A for his/her final overall grade in RD095.
- (2) Be eligible to take EN 101A—which means the student must earn a grade of B or better in either EN 001 or EN 002 or have the appropriate Accuplacer score.
- (3) Earn a score of 80% or better on the approved reading advancement test (the RD 099 Final Exam).

If the student meets **all three of the above requirements**, the RD095 professor and/or the reading coordinator will review the student’s records and give an override to advance to RD120.
