Rules for Entries

- Only residents of Maryland, Virginia, and Washington, D.C. are eligible.
- There are no restrictions on subject matter.
- Entries must be typed, 10pt. or 12pt. letters, double spaced, no more than 26 lines per page, one-inch margins, and numbered pages.
- All stories must be less than 3,000 words and unpublished.
- Staple or paper clip story in the upper left-hand corner.
- Writer's name should not appear on the first page. Place a title on the first page.
- All entries must include a cover sheet that includes writer's name, address, and telephone number. The writer's name should NOT appear on subsequent pages of the story.
- The cover sheets shall be removed on receipt at Rockville City Hall, and each entry will be assigned a number before being sent to the judges. All entries will be judged.
- All entries MUST follow the afore-mentioned format.
- Entries will not be returned.
- First prize is \$1,000 plus an invitation to speak briefly about the story at the Thirteenth Annual F. Scott Fitzgerald Literary Conference award ceremony on Saturday, October 25, 2008 at Montgomery College in Rockville, Maryland. The winning entry will be printed in the 2008 conference program. The winning story will be published in the Potomac Review.
- Three runner-up prizes of \$200 each will be awarded at the conference.
- Entries must be postmarked no later than **July 18, 2008**.
- **The entry fee is \$25 per entry.** Please make the check payable to: F. Scott Fitzgerald Literary Conference, Inc. (This entry fee is waived if you are a FSF member.)
