PROGRAM QUALIFICATIONS

MC students may enroll on a rolling basis; those who have completed 12 credits with a minimum 3.2 GPA are eligible for participation in Program Benefits described below.

PROGRAM BENEFITS

All TSA participants will be extended special benefits including:

- Access to UMBC/USG facilities and campus services including libraries and computer labs.
- Participation in student activities including [cultural](#) and [recreational](#) opportunities.
- Access to UMBC academic advising resources.
- Concurrent enrollment at a 25% tuition discount for one [UMBC course](#) per term (not to exceed a total of three discounted courses).

UPON SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF THE PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS, TSA PARTICIPANTS RECEIVE:

- Guaranteed transfer admission to UMBC.
- Guaranteed on-campus housing upon initial matriculation at UMBC (students may re-contract for housing for subsequent years of study).
- A \$1,500 merit scholarship for each of two years of full-time study.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Complete an [associates degree](#) with a minimum cumulative 3.5 composite-GPA within four years of initial program qualification.
- Enroll at [UMBC](#) or in a [UMBC program at the Universities at Shady Grove](#) within one year of completion of the associates degree.
- Must not matriculate at any other institution of higher education after program acceptance.

HOW TO ENROLL

Enrollment forms for the TSA Program are accepted on a rolling basis. High school seniors and first semester college freshmen are encouraged to enroll at any time. For participation in the program benefits (access to facilities, advising resources, campus events and reduced tuition courses), please be sure to submit a TSA form by the following dates:

- Students who anticipate having at least 12 credits and a cumulative 3.2 GPA by the end of the current semester should enroll by January 1 to participate in program benefits for the following Spring semester, and by May 1 for the following Fall semester.
