Montgomery College and Hood College Honors Agreement

Montgomery College (MC) students who are admitted to the Hood College Honors Program will be awarded a \$1,000 per semester Honors scholarship. This scholarship is stackable with other scholarships offered by Hood. Students will be guaranteed admission to the Hood College Honors Program once they have met the following criteria:

- Have applied and been accepted to Hood College as a full-time student
- Have successfully completed the MC Honors Program
- Have completed an AA, AS, or AAT degree and/or a minimum of 56 credits
- Have earned at least a 3.7 cumulative GPA at the time of application to Hood College

Through a combination of classroom instruction and co-curricular activities, the Hood College Honors Program offers a challenging academic experience that encourages both independent and collaborative learning. Transfer students who are accepted into the Hood College Honors Program are required to successfully complete the following:

- At least 3 credits of HON 470 Seminar
- At least 6 additional upper-level Honors credits (300 and 400-level courses)
 - o Study abroad (3 credits) and/or Departmental Honors Paper (3 credits) can be used to satisfy part of the 6 credits requirement
- Foreign Language Requirement
 - Demonstrate proficiency in a foreign language at the 203-level (by coursework or placement exam), or
 - Successfully complete any two foreign language courses at Hood, or
 - Successfully complete one foreign language course at Hood and one course from the designated list of global cultures courses

To graduate from Hood's Honors Program, students must earn a C- or better in all Honors courses and maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.25.

Other Provisions

- This agreement becomes effective upon the signature of both parties and shall continue to be in effect until both parties agree in writing to modify or terminate the agreement.
 Termination of the agreement shall become effective ninety (90) days after written notice is given.
- At the time of termination, students who have already transferred to Hood through this agreement will continue to receive the honors scholarship.

SIGNATORIES

This agreement represents our understanding that students who adhere to the requirements will have the ability to transfer from MC to Hood in accordance with Hood's Transfer Student Policy.
