- \* UMCP's Global Engagement Requirement must be fulfilled in one of 3 ways:
- 1: Study of a foreign language (See UMCP advisor for appropriate course number)
- 2: Cultural Immersion through Study Abroad (would be completed through UMCP)
- 3: Individually-designed Engagement Experience (would be completed through UMCP)

Students may be exempt if they speak a foreign language (offered by UMCP) fluently. Students who have advanced language experience or speak one of the approved languages fluently will take a supervised exam (would be completed through UMCP).
