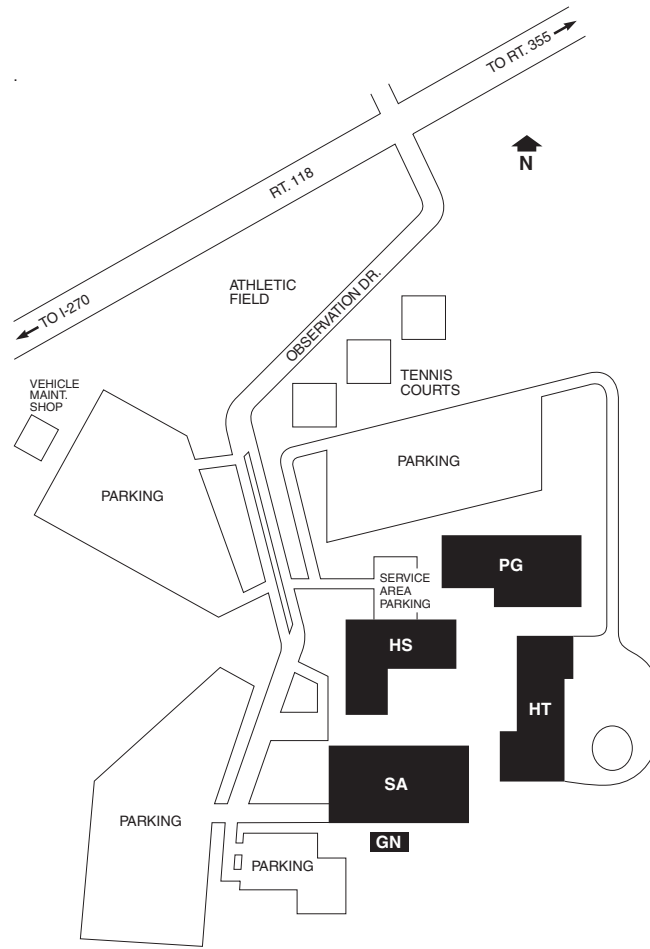

Directions to the Germantown Campus

Take I-495, the Beltway, to I-270 north—Frederick. Take Exit I5 East—Rt. 118 north to Rt. 355. Continue about one mile to the traffic light at Observation Drive; turn right. Follow Observation Drive into the campus to the visitors' parking lot on the right. The campus is also easily accessible from the Shady Grove Metro station via the Ride-On bus.
