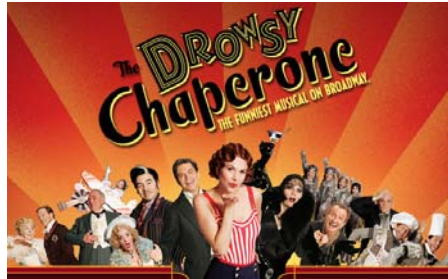

We are instantly immersed in the hilarious tale of a glamorous bride and her uproarious wedding day, complete with thrills and surprises that take both the cast (literally) and the audience (metaphorically) soaring into the heavens.
- Sunday afternoon we will see *Curtains*, a savagely funny new musical comedy, starring four-time Emmy Award-winner David Hyde Pierce ("*Frasier*," *Spamalot*) and Tony Award®-winner Debra Monk '72 (*Redwood Curtain*, *Steel Pier*, "*NYPD Blue*"). *Curtains* unfolds backstage at Boston's Colonial Theatre in 1959. When the star dies on opening night during her curtain call, Lieutenant Frank Cioffi arrives on the scene to investigate. But the lure of the theatre proves irresistible—and he finds himself just as drawn toward making the show a hit, as he is in solving the murder.

The basic cost of the trip is \$660* per person, which includes a lecture about *New York and the Theatre*, transportation, accommodations for two nights at the Grand Hyatt Hotel, and two top Broadway shows. Meals are not included. Reservations and a deposit of \$330 per person are being accepted on a first-come basis, with the balance of \$330 due by **September 28, 2007**.

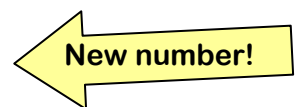
