- 1 Last date to complete transfer I-20 applications for the spring 2009 semester. (Forms are required for international students who need F-1 immigration status.)

## November

- 3 **Prospective May graduates:** Students who plan to graduate in May 2009 should apply for graduation by this date; students who are missing any degree requirements will have time to try to register in the needed classes before the spring semester begins.
- 3 To assure evaluation prior to the start of the spring semester, official transcripts must be received in the Office of Admissions and Records by this date.
