Students are asked to submit their scholarship applications no later than **June 13, 2008**. For priority review, applications are considered as they are received. Scholarship applications may be submitted to the Office of Student Financial Aid at any of the three campuses. Please complete your application carefully and thoroughly as early as possible.

If selected for a scholarship, recipients must agree to:

- a) send a letter of thanks to the scholarship sponsor
- b) send a copy of the letter to the Office of Student Financial Aid
- c) attend a meeting of the club or organization if requested
- d) attend the Montgomery College scholarship recognition event to thank donors and promote the scholarship program

Every effort will be made to review applications in a timely manner and notify recipients as quickly as possible. If you have any questions, please visit or call your campus Financial Aid Office.
