Hot Tips: Reservations & Book Credits

Reservations (for registered students)



Special points to remember:

- www.montgomerycollege.edu/financialaid/
- All documents must be complete and the FAFSA results must be on file and show an EFC number to ask for a Reservation.
- Not all aid can be used to request a Reservation.
- Book credits are available if your file is awarded.
- Complete the book credit request before the first week of the school term.



The Reservation of Classes can help to conserve cash for other school related expenses.

A request of Class Reservation is a service that allows you to hold your class schedule beyond the MC payment due date. All of your required forms and documents must be submitted to the financial aid office in order to complete a Request for Class Reservation.

You must contact the campus Financial Aid Office individually, to request this service.

A financial aid representative will review your documentation on file including the FAFSA and any additional documents required for verification of your data. The financial aid representative will determine if the preliminary data appears to make you eligible for a financial aid program that can pay for your tuition and fees for the semester.

If some or all of your tuition and fees will be expected to be paid by the estimated aid, you may receive a Reservation and your classes will be put on hold. You will receive a copy of the signed form which will show the expected dollar amount of the award(s). You are responsible for paying the remainder of the tuition and fees that aid will not cover, if any.

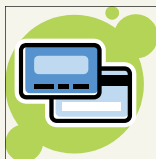
The Reservation allows you to attend classes while the financial aid processing continues on your file after classes begin. **If the information you submitted results in a different financial aid award than the preliminary expectation, you may owe the bill for all of your tuition and fees.**

If you change your enrollment, withdraw from some or all of your classes or change your registration to "Audit" status, or fail your classes, you may not be eligible for financial aid and you owe the bill.

Book Credits



Book Credits

A book credit is a service that allows you to charge required books and supplies (not food items, magazines, or non-class related clothing items) at your campus bookstore. In general, this service is available to you if you have been awarded prior to the start of the semester.

A book credit is not additional financial aid. Dollar amounts charged at the bookstore against a book credit are added to your Montgomery College student account and will reduce the amount of any refund of financial aid you may receive for the semester.

Book credits are not available for summer sessions.



Register early so that the books can be made available to you for the beginning of classes.
