

Winter Session Enrollments and Student Characteristics

January 2007-2008-2009-2010-2011-2012

Winter Session classes began in the Winter of 2007 and have grown in offerings and enrollment over the six years that this three-week session has existed. Students have increased from 459 to 1,522, hours of enrollment have climbed from 1,189 to 4,252, and course sections have grown from 19 to 88. Very few of the Winter students are new-to-MC or new-to-college in Winter-more than 90% are MC students from previous terms. By race and gender, the Winter students are similar to Fall or Spring semester students, although Asian and White students attend Winter at higher proportions, while Black and Hispanic students attend in slightly lower proportions than in Fall or Spring. Winter students are also considerably younger at 22 - 23 than "regular semester" students who average 26 years of age.
