1. The option provides additional space to meet projected enrollment growth on the campus.
2. The option supports the campus community with adequate learning, working, relaxation, celebration, and recreational environments.
3. The option eliminates fragmentation of disciplines, programs, and services.
4. The option allows the campus to retain its character, including the recognition of student diversity and encouraging interaction among students, faculty, and staff.
5. The option reinforces the College and campus as a community resource.
6. The option improves the quality of life for those who attend or work on the Rockville campus.
7. The option takes into consideration the economic impact of land acquisition, facilities leasing, shuttle services, and renovation and/or construction of facilities.
8. The option takes into consideration current zoning and building regulations of the City of Rockville, Montgomery County, and the State of Maryland.
- ~~9. The option allows for sufficient new facilities or the relocation of functions on the campus before proceeding with renovations that will take space off-line.~~
- 9.10. The option respects student, campus, and community needs for gathering spaces, educational spaces, access, and parking.

11. 12. The option respects community concerns about water management, traffic flow, and safety.
