Montgomery College has no dormitories or other residential facilities. The Campus Security Act was amended in 1998 to enlarge campus geographic boundaries to include adjacent public properties and thoroughfares. This may result in increased reported numbers for 1999 and future years. 2006 data reflect increases in the category of Burglary; and decrease in alcohol arrests due to variations in Maryland and Clery reporting criteria. Data is collected and reported following the FBI Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) system. Crimes involving injury that were motivated by hate or bias have a hate crime notation, (i.e.: Aggravated Assault 3 *ra-1*) the example shows a total of 3 aggravated assaults, of which, 1 was race motivated. **Key To Hate Crimes:** Race = ra Gender = g Religion = re Sexual Orientation = s Ethnicity = e Disability = d *Denotes crime did not occur on any campus grounds but was a police occurrence in the surrounding area. **In or on non campus building or property:** Would include crimes on or around Montgomery College School of Art & Design, Wheaton Plaza South; Gaithersburg Center; Office of Intuitional Technology .

2006 Clery Crime Statistics

Sex Offenses

Rockville Campus:

- 2006 one forcible sexual assault report was that of forcible fondling where an individual grabbed a female's private parts.
- 2005 was a forcible rape when a non-student female was dragged on our campus by the woods after hours

Robbery (includes Attempted Robberies)

Germantown:

- Two students stated they had been robbed by gunpoint in parking lot area. The original report indicated security officers believed the subjects were in Police custody.
- One individual stated he was approached by four individuals who wanted his wallet. A fight ensued and the subjects fled the scene. (Attempted Robbery which placed the victim in fear).

Rockville:

- A student stated a friend tried to rob him of his wallet. (Attempted Robbery victim filed a Police report)

Aggravated Assault

Rockville:

- Former student visiting campus stated he was assaulted by a known individual after a verbal dispute escalated into a physical assault. Victim claimed some form of metal object was used in a blow to his eye.
- Student stated she sustained head and face injuries by a known individual after a verbal dispute escalated into a physical assault.

Burglary

Rockville:

- Employee left wallet on desk and later discovered credit cards missing.
- Employee left office door open and discovered wallet was missing.
- Employee stated she left wallet in a locked office and upon return the office was unlocked and her wallet was missing.
- Employee reported laptops missing from a locked office area.
- Employee missing money from a desk drawer.
- Employee reported a ceramic dish was missing from her office.
- Employee reported missing wallet from her cubicle.
- Employee reports two college lap-tops were stolen from his place of residence. (This is not in the Clery crimes-just though I would note it).

Germantown:

- Employee claimed in a phone report her credit cards had been taken out of her opened door office from a plain site tote.
- Employee claimed a recovered book bag had been stolen from his office earlier.
- Employee claimed a large amount of money taken from his office that was locked. The key to his office is kept on a hook outside of his office door.
- Stolen food items from cafeteria after hours reported.

Takoma Park/Silver Spring:

- Employee stated a College radio was taken from his office.
- Employee stated a College lap top was missing from her office.
- Employee stated a wallet was missing from her office in an unlocked drawer.
- Employee stated a College VHS tape was missing from her office.
- Employee stated a College digital camera was missing from his office.

Arson

Takoma Park/Silver Spring:

- The Fire Department classified arson when random pieces of paper were discovered set a blazed and placed in a plastic bin in a campus building.

Motor Vehicle Theft

Rockville:

- Student discovered her car keys and car missing on campus.

Takoma Park/Silver Spring:

- Employee reported her van missing from Health Science Parking Lot. The subject was caught on tape stealing the vehicle and information was turned over to Montgomery County Police.
