Maryland Model for School Readiness Domain Training



The Maryland Model for School Readiness (MMSR) is a training series developed by the Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE). Training is designed for child care providers who are interested in improving the quality of their child care/early education setting. The training focuses on techniques for observing and documenting individual children's progress in major learning domains, specifically, personal and social development, language and literacy, mathematical and scientific thinking, social studies, arts, and physical development. The Pearson Work Sampling System will be used as the framework for collecting and sharing relevant information about children with their parents. This class assists teachers to truly know their classroom children and plan meaningful, developmentally appropriate learning opportunities on a daily basis.
