

## Word Problems involving Linear Equations

### Steps

- 1) READ THE PROBLEM
- 2) Draw a picture if it helps
- 3) Make a variable and write down what it stands for
- 4) Write an equation involving the variable
- 5) Solve the equation
- 6) Interpret and check the result. Make sure you answered the question that was asked.
