



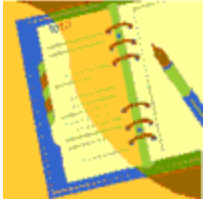
How are notebooks graded?

Students are required to maintain a 3-ring binder [minimum 1½ inch] notebook divided into the following sections: (1) Notes, (2) Classwork, (3) MathXL Homework, and (4) Tests/ Quizzes. Papers must be organized and secured in the notebook. The syllabus should be placed in the front of the notebook [ahead of the four sections].

No two notebooks look exactly the same, but we can make some generalizations. A good notebook (one that receives a high grade):

- has included all the class notes clearly and neatly having taken special effort to note everything that was discussed in class
- is legible and carefully written (PLEASE!)
- is titled and dated
- shows active involvement in the class (incorporates points from class discussion, continues a class comment, asks questions and attempts to answer questions left unsaid or incomplete)
- is thoughtful and includes meaningful entries
- has writing/journal entries that are at least ten sentences in length, and each entry is dated and titled
- shows effort and improvement
