

MATHEMATICS COMPETITION

The Department of Mathematics at Montgomery College – Rockville is once again participating in the AMATYC Student Math League – a competition open to students at 2-year colleges nationwide. All Montgomery College students who have not earned a 2-year or higher degree are invited to participate.

Training sessions will be held every Thursday, from 12:30-1:30 pm, starting 9/10 in Science East 228.

The competition will be held on Friday October 23, from 2:00-3:00pm, in Science East 119

The questions are at the level of Pre-Calculus Mathematics or lower, so students in MA180 or higher are especially encouraged to participate.

Please note:

1. The training sessions are optional, but will be interesting and helpful. Each week we will start with a discussion on a topic that is likely to appear on the competition, and then practice on problems drawn from old competitions. Grab some lunch, and come join us to pick up some new techniques and shortcuts.
2. This is the 1st of 2 rounds. You may participate whether or not you intend to compete in the 2nd round.
3. The national winner will win a \$3000 scholarship from AMATYC to any accredited 4-year institution.

The Montgomery College – Rockville team ranked #1 in the state of Maryland last year, and 2nd in the Mid-Atlantic Region.
