

MATHEMATICS COMPETITION

for students in MA180 or higher

The Mathematics Department at Montgomery College – Rockville is participating in the AMATYC Student Math League. This competition is open to students at two-year colleges nationwide. The questions are at the level of Pre-Calculus Mathematics or lower, so all Montgomery College students in MA180 or higher are especially encouraged to participate.

Training sessions will be held **Tuesdays**:

September 20, September 27, October 4, October 11, October 18

from 3:00 – 4:00 pm in Science West 122. During these sessions we will discuss general strategies to help you perform better in the competition, and practice on problems of the types that typically appear. Please feel free to come to as many of these sessions as your schedule allows – if you can make some sessions but not others, that is fine.

Please note:

1. The training sessions are optional, but will be helpful (and interesting!). Each week we will start with a discussion of a different topic that is likely to appear on the competition, and then practice on problems from old competitions.
2. The national winner will receive a \$3000 scholarship from AMATYC to any accredited 4-year institution. Other prizes will be awarded for top performers, and certificates of merit will be awarded to the top scorers at Montgomery College by the Math Department.
3. Training and competing are free. You don't need to register in advance for the training sessions or the competition, just show up!
