Call to Order

Approval of Minutes and Agenda

Constituent Concerns

- **Our role:** The Academic Services Council is to consider discussions on academic support programs including assessment centers, labs, registration, scheduling, website information, and transfer and articulation agreements, and forward suggestions to the College Council, the Senior Vice Presidents or other councils, as appropriate, for further consideration and/or action.

- Student Geovanka Levine
 - Online considerations: universal design, accessibility & equity
 - Adjustments may be needed for added technology for unique challenges
 - What’s really important in a new learning environment
 - Accommodate learning
 - Concessions maybe needed
 - Solutions

- Within reason for instructors to recognize that assessment modes may be prohibitive
 - Efforts to connect classmates with each other can add a layer of a burden for students
 - Well-meaning design may not always meet the need or may create additional burdens
 - Mental load for meaningful engagement can overload students
 - Do we really need to make up for socialization?
 - What resources do students have to cope?
 - Are we equitable in our delivery?
 - Neurodiversity considerations
 - Steering committee for Universal Design
 - Dr. Fiona Glade shared about upcoming plans currently in committee
 - Accessibility, equity, inclusion
 - Neurodiversity challenges can be difficult to accommodate in the classroom
 - There's a need to meet students where they are
 - Students may need an opportunity to process
 - When there is an assignment everyone responsible for, maybe we can have accommodations for capable students for whom a certain assignment may pose an undue burden
 - Environmental stressors
 - May be more impactful for some students more than others
- Conclusion: Council will deliberate and invite representatives from DSS and Universal Design
- Rachel Bonaparte, Interim Director of the Part-Time Faculty Institute for Engagement and Support
 - Institute mission
 - What the Institute does
 - General hub of information
 - Current structure
 - Few full staff
 - Director, administrative aides, Senior Part-Time Faculty Associates, Part-Time Faculty Associates
 - Role of Part-Time Faculty Associates (PTFA)
 - Deans & Chairs select
 - PTFA provide support both to Departments and part-time faculty and host sessions
 - Connect PTF to resources
 - Just liaisons; not SEIU Local 500 Representatives

- Not substitutions for other roles
 - Engagement-focus only
 - Working on including everyone
 - Highlights:
 - high numbers of participation
 - support ELITE training
 - Fellowships
 - Monthly spotlights
 - Resource Guide
- Conclusion: Requested that guidance on EC & Dual-Enrolled Students be placed in the Resource Guide for Part-Time faculty.
