Call to Order

- The regular meeting was called to order at 2:35 p.m. by Chair Katie Goldstein.
- The meeting was recorded for internal use only.
- The meeting began with roll call.

Constituent Concerns

- Christiane Bonkoungou raised a concern about the location and size of serenity spaces on campus.
 - This concern was raised at the last meeting, and Dr. Benjamin was going to meet with the Muslim Student Association to address this. Dr. Benjamin is not present to give an update.
- Nghi Nguyen asked via email if there are plans for the MK building to have prox cards installed.
 - James Gillis reports there are no plans to do this at this time.
- Nghi Nguyen asked via email if electric vehicle charging stations could be installed at the MK building parking lot, and if all charging stations could be upgraded to the quick chargers.
 - James Gillis will seek more information on this and report out at the May meeting.
- Katie Goldstein: The SV building vending machines only accept cash. Can they be upgraded to accept credit cards?
 - James Gillis suggested working with Bradley Bridges, Director of Auxiliary Services. Katie Goldstein will follow up with Director Bridges.
- Katie Goldstein followed up on a previous constituent concern regarding the vending machine in the TT building. This machine has been restocked and the constituent concern can be closed.
- Katie Goldstein reported that classrooms in the HU building are uncomfortably warm.
 - James Gillis reported that the buildings have not yet been switched to cooling. Instructors can submit a service desk ticket a few hours before the class takes place to request that the temperature be lowered.
- David Burkart requested updates on two previous constituent concerns:
 - Water fountains not working in SW building: James Gillis reported that those were turned back on.
 - Request for Raptor Charging station in Ackerman Science Learning Center: James Gillis reported that OIT has the charging stations in stock. He will submit an IT service desk ticket to install one in the Ackerman Center.
