- There was an incident in MK 342 Suite yesterday where a male student came in and sat in our suite in the middle of the suite. He is a student with learning disabilities, so I didn't want to kick him out. However, with everything going on, some of my colleagues felt a bit unsafe with the male student sitting there. One of them reached out to security, and security did come and escort the student back down to the second floor. Not sure what can be done in this situation for staff, who may be by themselves in a suite.
- Sometimes, parents take their kids and leave them out on the MK building waiting area while they're in class (WDCE classes, I assume). While the kids are not misbehaving, and the parents may not have anyone to look after the kids at home while they're in class, the College does have policy about having kids on campus. Maybe there needs to be a clear policy for parents to know before they take their minor kids on campus. For example, two weeks ago, a parent took her child with her and he threw up all over the floor in MK because he was having some kinds of bad reactions after visiting the dentist. Me and another staff

helped her and her son. In cases like this, or something worse, would the College be liable?
