Staff Awards Review

- Bebee Staff Distinguished Award
 - Minimum of five (5) years of service
 - Meeting at least one or more five criteria
 - o Peer-to-Peer nomination
 - o Does not require person's supervisor's approval for submission
 - Deadline is Friday, February 9
 - Recipient of award receives \$800
- Outstanding Staff Awards
 - Four main awards: Excellence in Performance, Excellence in Customer Service, Excellence in Innovation, and Excellence in Serving Students
 - Nominate the staff for ONE of these awards, not all and NOT for the Staff of the Year

- Recipient receives \$2000
- Can receive one award every three years, and the same award every 7 years
- Required: Nominator's letter, Supervisor's letter, Job Profile (supervisor will include from Workday), and three additional letters of support from faculty, staff, student, etc.
- Staff of the Year: one person from all the staff who are selected to receive the OSA will be selected for this award
 - Recipient receives \$5000
- Deadline is March 1
- Can be nominated after three years at MC
- Special Recognition Award
 - Year-round award
 - You can nominate any staff for this award who has done something wonderful for you (faculty, admin, staff can nominate any staff)
 - Does not require person's supervisor's approval for submission
 - Recipient gets \$400
 - Can be nominated after one year at MC
 - One award per year
