Updates on Mental Health Fair

- Who can put things up on the Digital Signage Board? Only registered student organizations, governance units, academic units, Student Affairs, administrative areas, and the Office of Communications are permitted to display content on the digital signage system.
- Are the images static or are video w/audio an option? Digital signage is an easily accessible tool for College announcements, news, student activities, open captioned videos, campus-generated content and events, as well as critical campus updates such as weather advisories and emergency information.
