

## GRADUATION/TRANSFER RATE: STUDENT RIGHT-TO-KNOW DISCLOSURE

In accordance with the Higher Education Act of 1965, and the Higher Education Opportunity Act of 2008, Montgomery College is reporting the graduation and transfer rates of students who entered the College in Fall 2015 as first-time, full-time, degree- or certificate-seeking students. The graduation and transfer rates are computed based on the student's status three years after entry.

Of the 1,998 students who entered as first-time, full-time, degree or certificate seeking students in Fall 2015, 21.8% had graduated and 22.1% had transferred to a baccalaureate postsecondary institution within three years, making the Montgomery College combined Graduation/Transfer rate 43.9% for the 2015 entering student cohort. The data below reflect Graduation/Transfer rates of the Fall 2015 cohort by race/ethnicity, gender and financial aid status.
