

GRADUATION/TRANSFER RATE – STUDENT RIGHT-TO-KNOW DISCLOSURE

In accordance with the Higher Education Act of 1965, and the Higher Education Opportunity Act of 2008, Montgomery College is reporting the graduation and transfer rates of students who entered the College in Fall 2020 as first-time, full-time, degree or certificate seeking students. The graduation and transfer rates are computed based on the student's status three years after entry.

Of 1,849 students who entered as first-time, full-time, degree or certificate seeking students in Fall 2020, 27.5% graduated and 21.8% transferred to a postsecondary institution within three years, making the Montgomery College combined Graduation/Transfer rate 49.3% for the 2020 entering student cohort. The data below reflect Graduation/Transfer rates of the Fall 2020 cohort by race/ethnicity, gender and financial aid status.
