NAMING OF THE ANTHONY D'SOUZA READING LOUNGE, TAKOMA PARK/SILVER SPRING CAMPUS LIBRARY

BACKGROUND

As a former faculty member of the Takoma Park/Silver Spring Campus, Professor Anthony D'Souza taught philosophy and English at Montgomery College from 1991-2009. Leaving the priesthood in his native country, he came to the United States from India in 1971. Here, he built positive and lasting relationships with colleagues and students over his career.

Professor D'Souza's commitment to Montgomery College continued for many years after his retirement. He regularly visited the Takoma Park/Silver Spring Library as a life-long learner who enjoyed being on campus in a welcoming community.

In November 2022, Montgomery College Foundation received a gift commitment of \$20,000 from Professor D'Souza's son, Vijay, supporting the Friends of the Libraries Fund. This gift will support the library's ability to continue offering resources and services to Montgomery College students.

In recognition of the personal philanthropy of the D'Souza family, as well as the professional commitment of Professor Anthony D'Souza to the College's mission, it is proposed that the College name the Reading Lounge in the Takoma Park/Silver Spring Campus Library as the "Anthony D'Souza Reading Lounge."

Explanation of Request:	The senior vice president for administrative and fiscal services and the vice president of facilities are requesting an award of contract to replace a diesel generator and add the existing fire pump to the new generator load, to support 24-hour emergency operation of the Central Dispatch Center at the Central Services building.
	Replacement is needed as the existing diesel generator is beyond its life expectancy. The new generator will provide 24-hour emergency operation of Security's Central Dispatch Center by supporting HVAC/ventilation and lighting requirements.

WHEREAS, The senior vice president for administrative and fiscal services and the vice president of facilities are requesting an award of contract to renovate the corporate central dispatch mechanical and electrical infrastructure systems at the Central Services Building; and

WHEREAS, Replacement is needed as the existing diesel generator is beyond its life expectancy; and

WHEREAS, The director of procurement certifies that specifications were developed by appropriate College staff, and the chief business/ financial strategy officer certifies that planned expenditures are available in the FY24 capital budget; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Md. (Educ.) Code Ann. Sec. 16-311 (c), a request for proposal was issued on July 31, 2023, and posted on the Montgomery College Procurement and State of Maryland eMaryland Marketplace Advantage websites; and

WHEREAS, 34 firms downloaded the request for proposal, of which, nine were identified as minority business enterprises; and

WHEREAS, One response was received, read aloud, and recorded in the Office of Procurement, beginning at 2:00 p.m. on September 5, 2023; and

WHEREAS, After an evaluation of Part A (Contractor Qualification proposal) of sole bidder's submitted proposal, it was deemed qualified to have its price proposal opened and evaluated (Part B); and

WHEREAS, Following the evaluation of Part B, it was determined that pricing submitted by sole bidder Henley Construction Company, Inc. of Gaithersburg, Maryland, in the amount \$713,700, includes all necessary material and labor, meeting all College specification requirements; and

WHEREAS, This resolution aligns with Montgomery College Strategic Plan Goal 3: Enhance educational and organizational effectiveness; and

WHEREAS, Awards resulting from competitive sealed proposals valued above \$250,000 require approval of the Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS. The president of the College recommends the following action; now therefore be it

<u>Resolved</u>, That the Board of Trustees approve an award of contract to renovate the corporate central dispatch mechanical and electrical infrastructure systems at the Central Services building,

to Henley Construction Company, Inc. of Gaithersburg, Maryland, for a one-time purchase in the amount of \$713,700; and be it further
