Statutory Authority to Close Session Under General Provisions 3-305(B):

□ 1.	To discuss the appointment, employment, assignment, promotion, discipline, demotion, compensation, removal, resignation, or performance evaluation of an appointee, employee, or official over whom this public body has jurisdiction; or any other personnel
	matter that affects one or more specific individuals;
\square 2	To protect the privacy or reputation of an individual with respect to a matter not related to public business;
	To consider the acquisition of real property for a public purpose and matters directly related to the acquisition;
	To consider a matter that concerns the proposal for a business or industrial organization to locate, expand, or remain in the State;
	To consider the investment of public funds;
	To consider the marketing of public securities;
	To consult with counsel to obtain legal advice;
	To consult with staff, consultants, or other individuals about pending or potential litigation;
	To conduct collective bargaining negotiations or consider matters that relate to the negotiations;
□10.	To discuss public security, if the public body determines that public discussion would constitute a risk to the public or to public
	security, including:
	i. the deployment of fire and police services and staff; and
	ii. the development and implementation of emergency plans;
□11.	To prepare, administer, or grade a scholastic, licensing, or qualifying examination;
\square 12.	To conduct or discuss an investigative proceeding on actual or possible criminal conduct;
	To comply with a specific constitutional, statutory, or judicially imposed requirement that prevents public disclosures about a
	particular proceeding or matter;
□14	To discuss, before a contract is awarded or bids are opened, a matter directly related to a negotiating strategy or the contents of
	a bid or proposal, if public discussion or disclosure would adversely impact the ability of the public body to participate in the
	competitive bidding or proposal process.
□ 15	To discuss cybersecurity, if the public body determines that public discussion would constitute a risk to:

- i. security assessments or deployments relating to information resources technology;
- ii. network security information, including information that is:
 - 1. Related to passwords, personal identification numbers, access codes, encryption, or other components of the security system of a governmental entity;
 - 2. Collected, assembled, or maintained by or for a governmental entity to prevent, detect, or investigate criminal
 - 3. Related to an assessment, made by or for a governmental entity or maintained by a governmental entity, of the vulnerability of a network to criminal activity; or

iii, deployments or implementation of security personnel, critical infrastructure, or security devices.
