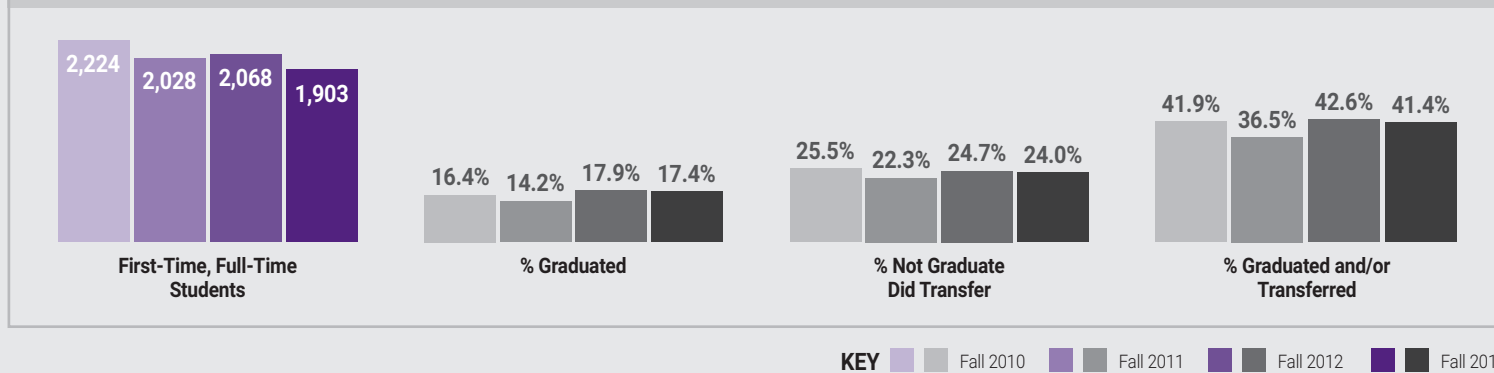

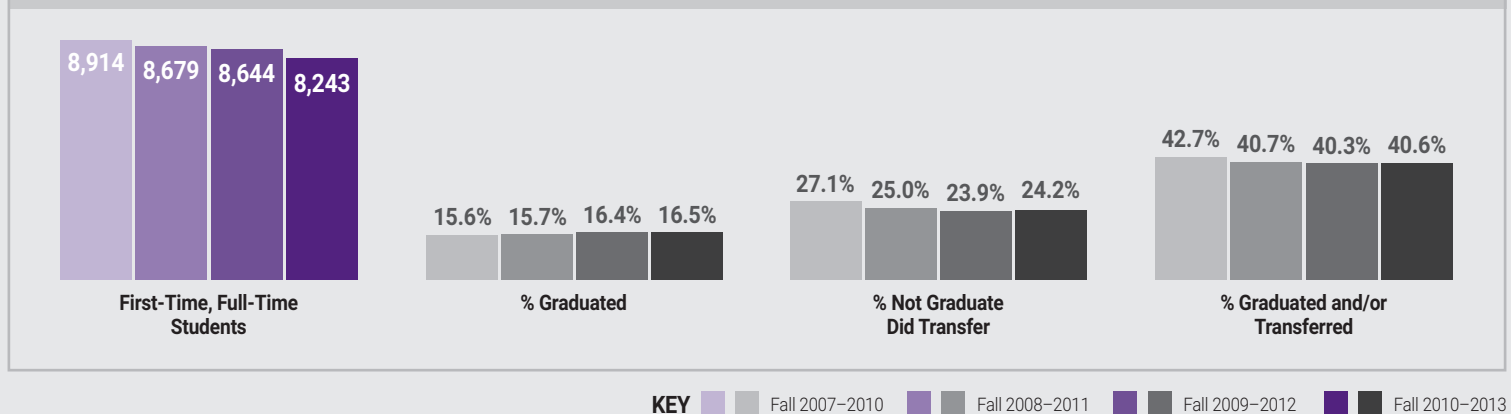

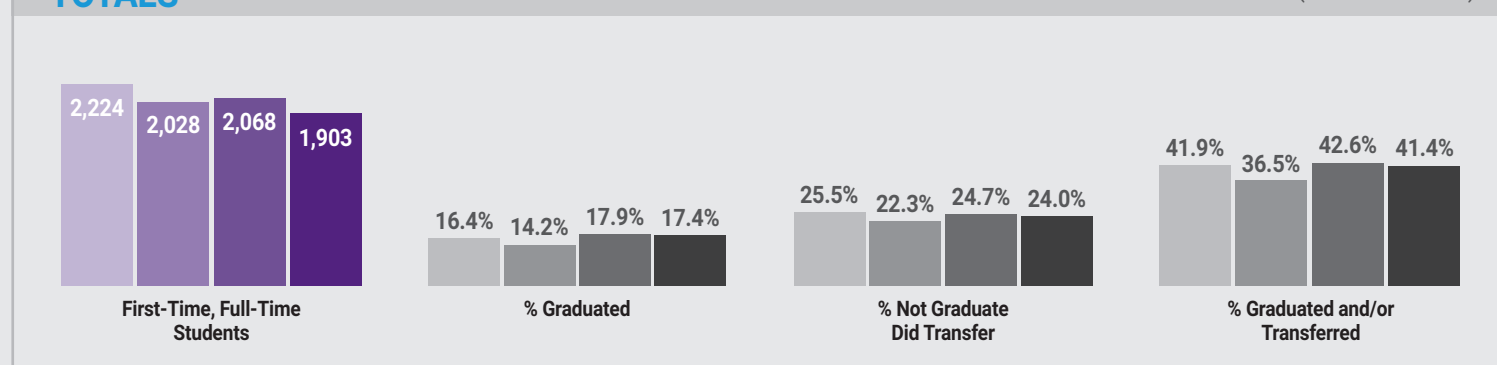

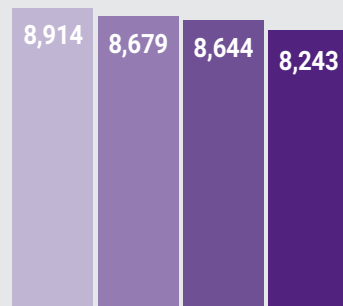

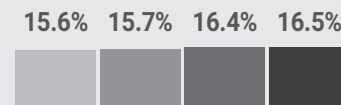

Three Years After Entry from Fall 2007–2010, Fall 2008–2011, Fall 2009–2012 and Fall 2010–2013**

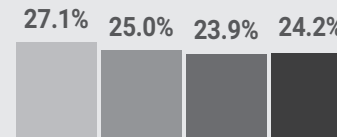

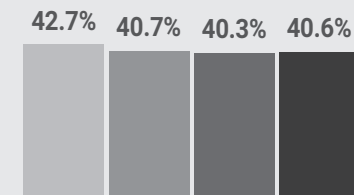
First-Time, Full-Time
