GOVERNOR APPOINTS MC STUDENT TO STATE COMMISSION

Our student Misale Endrias has been appointed by Governor Wes Moore and confirmed by the Maryland Senate to serve as Student Commissioner on the Maryland Higher Education Commission—the only student in the state selected for this role. As Misale prepares to transfer into a program that combines STEM and public policy, she will contribute to decisions on higher education policy, funding, and statewide priorities. At Montgomery College, she has championed the College’s Hunger-Free Campus Grant, served on the PIC MC Board, held leadership roles in Phi Theta Kappa, and completed a technology policy fellowship supporting research for the North Carolina state government. Her achievement reflects the leadership, preparation, and impact that define our students and the opportunities ahead of them.

RECOGNIZING OUR MOBILE MARKET VOLUNTEERS

Our Mobile Markets continue to reflect the strength of our community and our commitment to supporting students and families. From July 2025 through March 2026, in partnership with the Capital Area Food Bank, Montgomery College distributed 81.6 tons of food and served 6,125 households. This effort was powered by staff, faculty, students, and retirees who contributed 1,290 volunteer hours—an estimated \$45,575 in value.
