Montgomery College and Susquehanna University have established a new articulation agreement through The Momentum Program: The Montgomery–Susquehanna Transfer Advantage. This partnership creates a streamlined pathway for students to complete their bachelor’s degrees at Susquehanna University in Selinsgrove, Pennsylvania. Qualified students will benefit from guaranteed admission, financial aid, on-campus housing, and access to counseling services that support timely degree completion. MC has a long history of successfully preparing students for transfer to four-year institutions.
